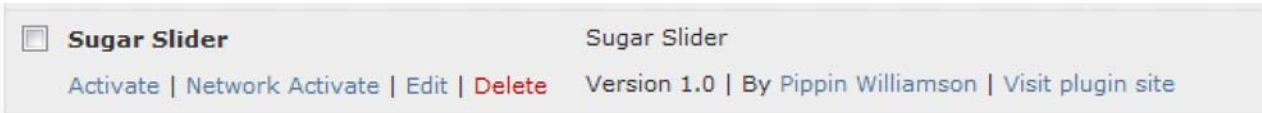


Sugar Slider Installation

1. Unzip *sugar-slider-v#.zip*
2. Upload the unzipped folder to wp-content/plugins
3. Navigate to your WordPress plugins menu
4. Click *Activate* under the *Sugar Slider* plugin title
5. Go to the Sliders Manager by clicking on *Sugar Slider* in the left navigation menu

Adding New Sliders (Shows)

To add a new slider, type in the name of the slider you wish to create in the input field titled *Show Name* at either the top or bottom of the screen.

Your new slider will appear below any current sliders already created.

Adding New Slides to a Slider

To add a new slide to a slider, click the *add slide* button at the bottom of the slider to which you wish to add the slide.

Choosing an Image for a Slide

First click, *Choose Image*, then either upload an image from your computer or choose an existing image from the media library.

Once you have chosen your image, click *Insert Into Post* to add the selected image to the slide.

Note: If you upload an image from your computer, you may need to click *Save Changes*, then choose the image from the Media Library in order to be able to insert the image into the slide. This is a limitation of the WP Media manager.

Inserting a Slider into a Post or Page

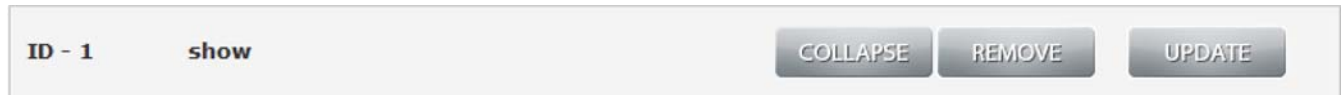
Place the shortcode `[sugar_slider id=#]` in a post or page to display a slider. Replace # with the unique ID number of the desired slider.

Inserting a Slider into a theme Template file

Use `<?php echo do_shortcode('sugar_slider id=#j'); ?>` to display a slider anywhere in your template files.

Finding the ID number of a Slider

The unique ID number of your slider is the number to the right of ID at the top of the slider.



Sugar Slider Settings Help

To configure settings, such as paginator style, pre/next style, and more, click *Settings* under the *Sugar Slider* menu.

Dot Nav Style

The Dot Navigator (more often referred to as pagination) is a simple form of slide control that allows you to click a "dot" to navigate to the next slide, or to any slide in the slideshow. You can choose the theme you wish to display by setting the "Dot Nav Style" select menu to the desired theme.

Prev /Next Style

The Prev / Next navigation is a set of links--Prev and Next--that allows you to move the slider forward or backwards by one slide. You can choose the Prev / Next navigation theme by selecting the desired style from the Prev / Nav Style select menu.

Custom CSS

If you wish to customize the appearance of the slider, please do so by entering your custom CSS in Custom CSS box. Please do not modify the CSS files included with the plugin.

NOTE: Customizing the CSS is only for users who are comfortable with HTML/CSS.

To assist you in any customization you may choose to do, here is a list of class names for sliders:

.ss-show-wrap	The DIV container that wraps the complete slider, including all controls.
.ss-slider	The UL that holds all slides
.ss-paginator	The DIV container that wraps the Prev / Next links.
.ss-prev / .ss-next	These target the Prev / Next links
.ss-slider-controls	The DIV container that wraps the Dot Navigator
.ss-control	The LI for each dot in the Dot Navigato

.sexyslider-title The slide captions

To target captions for a specific slider, use: **.ss-slider-ID .sexyslider-title**

Each of the above classes will apply to each and every slider you create. If you wish to **target only one, specific slider**, then simply append "**-ID**" onto the end of the class name, and replace ID with the unique ID number of the slider you wish to target. The ID number of any slider can be found by looking at the number to the left of the Show name in the Slider Manager.
